



# Phantom Lake Ice Patrol 2011 Report

To the members of PLMD,

Thank you to the members of the **Phantom Lakes Management District** for the generous contribution to the Town of Mukwonago Police Department, it was used to establish the Phantom Lake Ice Patrol. Your investment in the safety of Mukwonago citizens has made this possible. Special thanks to; **Mukwonago Yamaha** and **Rick Silkworth**, for their contribution of the Rhino. I would also like to thank, **Fred Leppin**, for the use of his snowmobile trailer. Thanks to the **Waukesha County Sheriffs Department** for their investment of time and resources in this cooperative effort. We are grateful to all those who contributed to make this a safe winter season on Phantom Lake.

The following information outlines the patrols on Phantom Lake in the early part of 2011;

On **Sunday, January 9, 2011**, Deputy Moonen and Deputy Kveen, from the Waukesha County Sheriffs Department conducted patrol on Phantom Lake from 2:45pm-11:00pm. At 4:54pm deputies stopped a truck for "Excessive Speed". The driver was cited for that violation. At 6:00pm deputies attempted to stop a vehicle for reckless driving, however, the vehicle fled. One (1) citation was issued.

On **Monday, January 17, 2011**, Deputy Mike Matoushek and Deputy Scott Ziorgen, from the Dodge County Sheriffs Department conducted training for the Town of Mukwonago Police Departments Staff. Training was conducted at the Town of Mukwonago Police Department with practical evaluations conducted at the Town Park, seven (7) officers were trained.

On **Saturday, January 22, 2011**, Sgt. Schmidt and Officer Ketola, from the Town of Mukwonago Police Department conducted patrol on Phantom Lake from 10:00am-6:00pm. Reggie's was holding their annual "Radar Run". At 12:42pm officers assisted a motorist that had put their truck through the ice. Throughout the rest of the time officers issued three (3) citations. One (1) for speed, one (1) for no safety certificate, and one (1) for non-registration. In addition, eight (8) warnings were given.

Deputies Moonen and Thompson from the Waukesha Sheriffs Department patrolled from 8:00am-2:40pm. They issued seven (7) citations. Five (5) for speed, one (1) for non-registration, and one (1) for no safety certificate. Three (3) warnings were given.

On **Friday, January 28, 2011**, Sgt. Schmidt and Officer Ketola from the Town of Mukwonago Police Department conducted patrol on Phantom Lake from 7:00pm-11:00pm. They issued two (2) citations for negligent operation of motor vehicle. Six (6) warnings were given.
